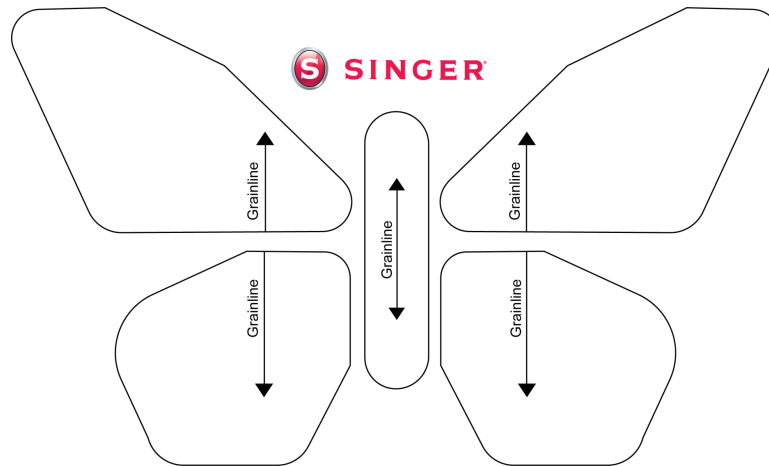

Butterfly Applique



Make your garment a masterpiece with these beautiful butterfly appliques!

Supplies:

Everything you need to complete this project in one place. Use this convenient checklist to ensure you have all required materials in your sewing room, or take it with you when you shop for supplies.

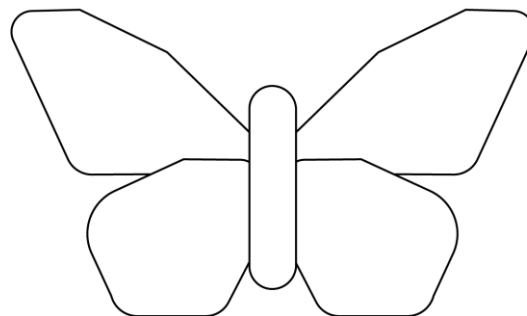
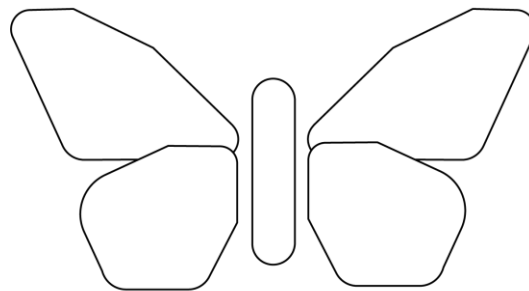
- 8"x11.5" Cotton Fabric
- Butterfly Applique Pattern (download on SINGER.com)
- 8"x11.5" INSPRIA™ Stick N' Fuse II (available on SINGER.com)
- 8"x11.5" INSPIRA™ Tear Away Stabilizer (available on SINGER.com)
 - If applying to stretchy fabric use INSPIRA™ Cut-A-Way™ Stabilizer
- Embroidery Thread
- Pins
- Scissors
- Pen/Pencil for tracing pattern design
- Iron and Ironing Board

Cutting Directions

Description	Cutting Instructions
Applique Fabric	(See Step 02) Cut out on solid black line following pattern shape
Tear Away Stabilizer	Cut 1 piece 10"x10"

Sewing Directions

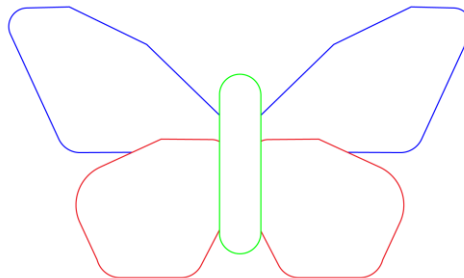
01. **BEFORE CUTTING:** According to the manufacturer's instructions, peel off the back side of the Stick N' Fuse II stabilizer and place exposed side of the stabilizer on to the **wrong** side of your applique fabric. Press thoroughly until stabilizer adheres to fabric.
02. Cut out all pieces from the Butterfly Pattern and lay pieces on the wrong side of your applique fabric. Trace each piece with paper side up with a pen or pencil. Cut out each fabric piece and place aside.
03. Take garment and lay flat on a heat-proof surface (ironing board) with right side up. Press area for applique flat until there are little to no wrinkles.
04. Take Butterfly Pattern pieces and arrange them on to the surface of garment starting with the top wings, then the bottom wings, then the center piece as like below:



05. Once arranged, pick up each piece and peel off the back paper on the Stick N' Fuse II and place back down on garment starting with the upper wings, then lower wings, then center piece.

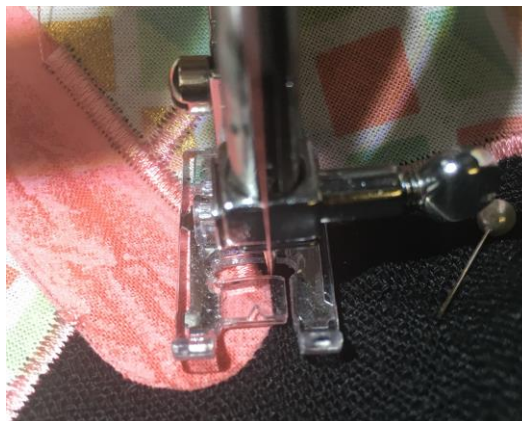


06. Once all of the Butterfly Pattern pieces are placed on to the garment, press thoroughly and use steam to set the appliques in place. Let cool.
07. Place the Tear Away Stabilizer underneath the garment and pin in place around the applique.
08. Set sewing machine to a satin stitch (see instruction manual for settings) and thread machine with embroidery thread and matching embroidery bobbin.
09. Starting with the upper wings (the blue lines), satin stitch around the edges of the Applique. Proceed to the lower wings (the red lines), and end with the center piece (the green lines).



Pro Tip:

Pivot when the needle is on the outside of the applique to prevent gaps in stitches (See below)



10. Once all of the raw edges are covered in a satin stitch, remove garment from machine and trim threads. Tear away the back stabilizer (Tear Away Stabilizer) and dispose. Press applique and garment flat to remove any wrinkles.
11. Wear and enjoy!
